## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing student leaders at Georgia Tech and welcoming them for Georgia Tech Student  
2 Day at the Capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Institute of Technology is a world-class university providing  
4 unmatched higher learning to over 20,000 undergraduate and graduate students; and

5 WHEREAS, these students are a driving force within the Institute's community, observing  
6 and participating as more than mere scholars in all corners of the campus and at nearly every  
7 functional level; and

8 WHEREAS, many of these students emerge as strong and capable leaders in their  
9 classrooms, organizations, and the entire Institute, demonstrating genuine interest in  
10 improving their local and global communities; and

11 WHEREAS, among those interests, these student leaders work together to achieve progress,  
12 service, and prestige for the Georgia Tech community; and

13 WHEREAS, supported by their teachers and administrators, these student leaders have  
14 endeavored to serve as strong, vocal advocates for the Institute to a variety of constituents,  
15 including Georgia's legislators and state leaders; and

16 WHEREAS, they demonstrate this effort today, once again joining us in the state capitol for  
17 the fourth annual Georgia Tech Student Day at the Capitol.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 recognize and commend these student leaders from the Georgia Institute of Technology for  
20 their commitment to the causes of their Institute and advocacy on its behalf and heartily
