A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing May, 2017, as Brain Tumor Awareness Month, and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, brain tumors both primary, originating in brain tissue, and secondary,
- 3 originating in other parts of the body that metastasize to the brain, are diagnosed in more than
- 4 220,000 Americans of all ages, races, socioeconomic status, and gender each year and the
- 5 rate continues to rise annually; and
- 6 WHEREAS, malignant brain tumors are among the deadliest forms of cancer with just a 34
- 7 percent five-year relative survival rate and are the leading cause of cancer related deaths in
- 8 children and adolescents, from birth to 19 years of age; and
- 9 WHEREAS, over 3,600 people in Georgia will be diagnosed with a brain tumor and 388 will
- 10 die from a brain tumor in 2017; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Georgia is home to major facilities, such as Emory Winship Cancer Institute
- and others, that focus on research to find better treatments, a cure for brain tumors, and a
- 13 higher quality of life for brain tumor patients; and
- 14 WHEREAS, increased public awareness of brain tumors through advocacy and support for
- 15 targeted research, as well as education about the impact brain tumors have on patients' and
- their families' lives, are critical to support and action for a cure.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 18 recognize May, 2017, as Brain Tumor Awareness Month.
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 20 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
- 21 press.
