A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 20, 2015, as Spelman College Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Spelman College was founded in 1881 as the Atlanta Baptist Female Seminary,
3 which became Spelman College in 1924; it is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of
4 the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools; it is also a member of the Atlanta
5 University Center Consortium; and

6 WHEREAS, Spelman College has long been recognized as the leading educator of women
7 of African descent; it is now named among the top 100 liberal arts colleges in the nation and
8 is one of the most selective women's colleges in the United States; and

9 WHEREAS, the Spelman student body comprises more than 2,100 students from 41 states
10 and 15 foreign countries; Spelman empowers women to engage the many cultures of the
11 world and inspires a commitment to positive social change through service; Spelman is
12 dedicated to academic excellence in the liberal arts and sciences and the intellectual, creative,
13 ethical, and leadership development of its students.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 commend Spelman College and recognize March 20, 2015, as Spelman College Day at the
16 capitol.

18 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Spelman College.
