A RESOLUTION

- 1 Dedicating The Technology Corridor; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Forsyth County is home to roughly 8,000 residents who work in the technology
3 field; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the City of Alpharetta has more than 700 technology companies and helps
5 support Tech Alpharetta, a nonprofit that mentors young tech startups and fosters tech
6 business growth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, numerous technology companies are located along the Georgia 400 Highway,
8 including Scientific Games, Forte Data Systems, New Cyber Source, and Siemens; and
- 9 WHEREAS, leaders from the City of Alpharetta and Forsyth County are committed to
10 promoting technology companies and promoting the area as the technology destination of the
11 Southeast; and
- 12 WHEREAS, dedication of this route as a highway of progress will promote economic
13 development and attract more technology based businesses.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
15 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 400 from Mansell Road in
16 Fulton County to State Route 20 in Forsyth County is dedicated as The Technology Corridor.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
18 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating The Technology Corridor.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the Department
21 of Transportation.
