

Senate Resolution 527

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia so as to authorize the
 2 General Assembly to provide by law for the operation and regulation of game show contests
 3 in this state; to provide for related matters; to provide for the submission of this amendment
 4 for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article I, Section II, Paragraph VIII of the Constitution is amended by adding a new
 8 subparagraph to read as follows:

9 "(e) The General Assembly may provide by law for the operation and regulation of game
 10 show contests in this state and for any matters relating to such activity. The General
 11 Assembly may by law define a game show contest and such a contest may include a charge
 12 for an entry fee and the awarding of prizes to contestants."

13 SECTION 2.

14 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
 15 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
 16 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

17 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize the General
 18 () NO Assembly to provide by law for the operation and regulation of game show
 19 contests in this state?"

20 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

21 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
 22 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
 23 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
