Senate Resolution 53 By: Senators Beach of the 21st and Harbison of the 15th

## A RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia so as to provide for
pari-mutuel betting in this state under certain circumstances; to provide for related matters;
to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other
purposes.

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## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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#### **SECTION 1.**

7 Article I, Section II of the Constitution is amended in Paragraph VIII by adding a new8 subparagraph to read as follows:

9 "(e) The General Assembly may by law provide for the operation and regulation of 10 pari-mutuel betting on horse racing only on the premises of racetracks by or on behalf of 11 the state and for any matters relating to the purposes or provisions of this subparagraph. 12 No off-track or off-site pari-mutuel betting on horse racing under this subparagraph shall 13 be permitted or authorized. For the purpose of regulation and taxation of such activities. 14 the General Assembly shall create a gaming commission and provide the commission with 15 such powers and duties as necessary to provide appropriate regulation of pari-mutuel 16 betting on horse racing and to tax such activities. Proceeds derived from the regulation and 17 taxation of pari-mutuel betting on horse racing shall be used to pay the expenses of such

18 regulation and taxation and to fund educational programs and educational purposes, as 19 listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and rural health care services and health insurance coverage in this state. Such proceeds shall not be subject to Article VII, 20 21 Section III, Paragraph II; Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(a); or Article III, Section IX, Paragraph IV(c), except that the net proceeds after payment of such expenses of regulation 22 23 and taxation shall be subject to Article VII, Section III, Paragraph II. Net proceeds after 24 payment of such expenses of regulation and taxation shall be separately accounted for and 25 shall be specifically identified by the Governor in his or her annual budget presented to the 26 General Assembly as a separate budget category entitled 'Pari-mutuel Betting Proceeds' and 27 the Governor shall make specific recommendations as to the educational programs and 28 educational purposes, as listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and rural health care services and health insurance coverage to which such net proceeds shall be appropriated. 29 30 In the General Appropriations Act adopted by the General Assembly, the General 31 Assembly shall appropriate all net proceeds of pari-mutuel betting on horse racing by such 32 separate budget category to the provision of educational programs and educational 33 purposes, as listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and rural health care services and 34 health insurance coverage in this state. Such net proceeds shall be used to support 35 improvements and enhancements for educational programs and educational purposes, as 36 listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and rural health care services and health care 37 insurance coverage and such net proceeds shall be used to supplement, not supplant, 38 non-pari-mutuel betting resources for educational programs and educational purposes, as 39 listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and rural health care services and health 40 insurance coverage. Of such net proceeds, 75 percent shall be allocated to educational programs and educational purposes, as listed in subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph, and 25 41 percent to rural health care services and health insurance coverage. No pari-mutuel betting 42 43 on horse racing under this subparagraph shall take place in any county in this state unless 44 the electors of such county voting in a referendum on such authorization approve such

45	authorization. Such referendum shall be initiated either by the adoption of a resolution by
46	the governing authority of such county authorizing pari-mutuel betting on horse racing
47	within such county or by a petition by a number of electors of such county as provided by
48	general law for a referendum to authorize pari-mutuel betting on horse racing within such
49	county. The General Assembly shall provide by law procedures for such authorization."

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## **SECTION 2.**

51 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as 52 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the 53 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

54 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to authorize pari-mutuel

55 () NO betting on horse racing in this state under certain circumstances?"

56 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

57 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If

58 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall

59 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
