## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Mr. Shyam K. Reddy; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Shyam K. Reddy is the regional administrator of the Southeast Sunbelt

- 16 mergers and acquisitions, procurement and technology transactions, and venture captial and
- 17 private equity deals; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mr. Reddy has served on the boards of directors of the University of Georgia
- 19 College of Public Health, the University of Georgia Alumni Association, and Common
- 20 Cause of Georgia; and
- 21 WHEREAS, he obtained his bachelor's degree and master's degree in public health from
- 22 Emory University and his Juris Doctorate from the University of Georgia; and
