A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Christine Lowe Glass; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia continues to mourn the loss of one of its most distinguished
3 citizens with the passing of Christine Lowe Glass on January 7, 2023; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Christine Lowe Glass was born on October 11, 1934, in Atlanta, Georgia, a
5 beloved daughter of K.C. Lowe and Thelma Le Jackson Lowe; and
- 6 WHEREAS, known affectionately as "Silky Smooth," she was a lifetime member of Smooth
7 Ashlar Grand Lodge, actively participating for more than 47 years as part of all the female
8 departments and receiving numerous accolades; and
- 9 WHEREAS, she further served her community with dedication, contributing more than 25
10 years to vocational rehabilitation, and maintained an active role in civic responsibilities
11 including contributions to various ministries and community clubs; and
- 12 WHEREAS, she was honored with the United States Presidential Volunteer Lifetime Service
13 Award by President Joe Biden in October 2022 and was nominated for Miss 2023 Queens
14 of Pink; and

15 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Christine Lowe Glass was an active
16 member of First Corinth Baptist Church for more than 56 years; and

17 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Charles, and was blessed
18 with three remarkable daughters, Patricia, Thelma, and Sharon; 13 wonderful grandchildren;

20 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
21 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
22 her family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Christine Lowe Glass will long be
24 remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
25 had the great fortune of knowing her.
