## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on the Use and Sale of State Public Information; and
- 2 for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, state public information is by name a public record and should be available for
- 4 public review by individuals or business entities; and
- 5 WHEREAS, there are instances where the State of Georgia enters into contractual
- 6 agreements with single entity private vendors and cedes controlling interests in state public
- 7 information to those vendors; and
- 8 WHEREAS, vehicle identification number (VIN) and police-reported accident information
- 9 is critical for facilitating informed buying of used cars in Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, such information is a key component of educating consumers as to damage to
- vehicles and deployment of air bags; and
- 12 WHEREAS, a private vendor should not monopolize access to such state information, the
- 13 disclosure of which promotes public safety and protects consumers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, an exclusive vendor agreement for such state information has the potential to
- 15 imperil consumers, including denying them access to state public information that serves to
- 16 protect and inform; and
- 17 WHEREAS, an exclusive agreement for public information stifles market innovation when
- 18 new and existing companies managing such information are given complete authority to
- 19 determine which other businesses may access such public information for their products and
- 20 services, and under what terms; and

21 WHEREAS, policies supporting disclosure of public information through an open records

- 22 request process would serve to foster accountability in government and awareness by the
- 23 public; and
- 24 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to undertake a study of how to best promote open access
- 25 to vehicle crash data in light of existing technological advancements and whether any
- 26 changes need to be made to current state law in this area.
- 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:
- 28 (1) **Creation of Senate study committee.** There is created the Senate Study Committee
- on the Use and Sale of State Public Information.
- 30 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- 31 Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President shall designate a
- member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.
- 33 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 36 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 40 (5) Allowances and funding.
- 41 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate.
- 47 (6) **Report.**
- 48 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 52 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.

(C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
the Secretary of the Senate.

- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary of the Senate a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 61 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2017.
