- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Michael Langford; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Michael Langford on November 16, 2021; and
- 4 WHEREAS, as president of the United Youth Adult Conference, which was founded by his
5 late brother, Georgia State Senator Arthur Langford Jr., Michael inspired countless others
6 and was a vocal advocate for equity and inclusion; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Michael's service on the City of Atlanta's Anti-Violence Advisory Council
8 helped to increase awareness and engagement and empowered our community to improve
9 the lives of children and families; and
- 10 WHEREAS, as part of the Atlanta child murders investigation, he led search missions for the
11 missing children and most recently served on the Atlanta Children's Memorial Taskforce; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Michael gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
13 concern for his fellow citizens; and

14 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Michael will long be remembered for his
15 leadership and advocacy in the community and will be missed by all who had the great
16 fortune of knowing him.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 join in honoring the life and memory of Michael Langford and express their deepest and
19 most sincere regret at his passing.
