A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing January 22, 2018, as Effingham County Day at the state capitol; saluting the
2 Effingham County Chamber of Commerce; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, for a number of years, Effingham County has sponsored Effingham County Day
4 at the Georgia State Capitol, sending a delegation to visit with and entertain members of the
5 General Assembly and others at the state capitol; and

6 WHEREAS, Effingham County borders on the Savannah River; includes three incorporated
7 municipalities, Rincon, Springfield, and Guyton, and several smaller communities, such as
8 Meldrim, Faulkville, Pineora, Stillwell, Egypt, Clyo, Ebenezer, and Shawnee; and is widely
9 recognized for its outstanding quality of life; and

10 WHEREAS, Effingham County Day will again be observed on January 22, 2018, under the
11 sponsorship of the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce and its president, Ed Vance;

13 WHEREAS, the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce was founded in 1986 to support
14 existing businesses and attract new firms to the thriving business climate in the county; and

15 WHEREAS, the chamber today boasts more than 300 members from a wide variety of
16 businesses and contributes greatly to the community and the State of Georgia through its
17 work of "Bringing People and Opportunities Together."

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body does hereby
19 recognize January 22, 2018, as Effingham County Day at the state capitol and extends to the
20 Effingham County Chamber of Commerce its commendation for the chamber's many
21 important contributions to the Effingham County community and the State of Georgia.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
23 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Ed Vance,
24 president of the Effingham County Chamber of Commerce.
