A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Building Owners and Managers Association of Georgia (BOMA Georgia)
2 and recognizing February 20, 2024, as BOMA Georgia Day at the state capitol; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, founded in 1913 as BOMA-Atlanta, BOMA Georgia is a trade association that
5 has supported the commercial real estate industry in Georgia for more than 110 years; and

6 WHEREAS, the commercial real estate industry has grown to currently contribute nearly
7 \$5.5 billion to Georgia's economy annually while supporting nearly 50,000 jobs in the state;

9 WHEREAS, BOMA Georgia members are responsible for the ownership, management, and
10 administration of more than 150 million square feet of office space and additional millions
11 of square feet of facilities throughout Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, these individuals represent building ownership, professional property
13 management firms, professional service providers, and contract services across more than
14 40 other categories of specialty services, and BOMA Georgia members have been

15 instrumental in cementing Georgia as a national leader in commercial real estate over the past
16 century; and

17 WHEREAS, BOMA Georgia's educational programs enhance environmental sustainability,
18 build corporate responsibility, and contribute to the overall favorable business climate in
19 Georgia; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments and
21 history of this extraordinary organization be recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 commend the Building Owners and Managers Association of Georgia and recognize
24 February 20, 2024, as BOMA Georgia Day at the state capitol.
