- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Justin A. Pressley; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 3 with the passing of Justin A. Pressley, on August 3, 2018; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Justin leaves behind a glowing legacy as an indefatigable fighter who turned
- 5 his disability into a quest to improve the lives of others, as evidenced by his superlative
- 6 service as co-founder of the Disability Resource Center in Gainesville and Access to a Better

- 8 founder of the Georgia Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Trust Fund; and as a founding board
- 9 member of Our Neighbor, Inc.; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Justin was a warrior for the disabled community, devoting his time, talents, and
- service to organizations such as the Georgia Advisory Committee to the United States Civil
- 12 Rights Commission, the Georgia Rehabilitation Council, and the National Organization on
- 13 Disability; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he founded the North Georgia Screamin' Eagles power soccer team, chaired the
- 15 Georgia Games Power Soccer Committee, and was a torch bearer for the 1996 Olympic
- 16 Games; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Justin gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep
- 18 concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
- 19 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
- 21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
- 22 made this world a better place in which to live; and
