- 17 from abandoning their education by demonstrating a belief in their boundless potential;
- 18 conviction in the educational and motivational impact of relevant hands-on learning; respect
- 19 for the talents, creativity, perspective, and background of each individual; belief in the power
- 20 of partnership and collaboration; commitment to the principles of market-based economics
- 21 and entrepreneurship; and passion for what the organization does and a commitment to
- 22 honesty, integrity, and excellence in how it does it; and
