### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Dr. Calvin Wayne McClarin; dedicating a bridge in his memory;  
2 repealing a certain resolution; repealing conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens with the passing of Dr. Calvin  
4 McLarin on August 29, 2019; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Calvin McLarin was born in Atlanta, Georgia, the youngest of five children  
6 of George and Myrtis Young McLarin; and

7 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
8 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
9 family and friends were admired by others; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. McLarin was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable  
11 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of  
12 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and

13 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Dr. McLarin will long be remembered for  
14 his love of family and friendship, and this loyal brother and friend will be missed by all who  
15 had the great fortune of knowing him; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
17 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that:

20 (1) The bridge on 17th Street over I-75 in Fulton County is dedicated as the Dr. Calvin  
21 Wayne McClarin Memorial Bridge;

22 (2) The Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain  
23 appropriate signs dedicating the Dr. Calvin Wayne McClarin Memorial Bridge and remove  
24 any signs relating to previous dedications at this location;

25 (3) Part III and the third clause of Part XXIII of Senate Resolution 844, approved  
26 August 5, 2020 (Ga. L. 2020, p. 832), is hereby repealed;

27 (4) The Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized and directed to make  
28 appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of Dr. Calvin  
29 Wayne McClarin and to the Department of Transportation; and

30 (5) All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this resolution are repealed.
