## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Public Utility Once Source Billing of Local Governments Study
- 2 Committee; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, each facility operated by a local school district and each building owned by a
- 4 local government is presently billed separately for utilities; and
- 5 WHEREAS, if the rate charged by regulated public utilities were to be based on the total
- 6 usage of all facilities and buildings of a local school district and local government, such
- 7 aggregation of total usage would result in a lower rate per gallon of water or per kilowatt
- 8 hour of electricity; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a local school district and local government could still use separate meters to
- 10 track usage in each facility or building for efficiency, but the local school district or local
- government should be given credit for total usage to get a lower rate that would benefit all
- 12 taxpayers; and
- 13 WHEREAS, study is needed to thoroughly review current practices, develop potential
- legislation, and determine other actions that would maximize the benefits of one user billing
- 15 for local school districts, local governments, and Georgia taxpayers.

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- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:
- 17 (1) Creation of Senate study committee. There is created the Senate Public Utility
- Once Source Billing of Local Governments Study Committee.
- 19 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President shall designate a
- 21 member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.
- 22 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 25 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 26 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 27 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 29 (5) Allowances and funding. The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- 30 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 31 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate.
- 35 (6) **Report.**
- 36 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- 38 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- 39 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 40 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 42 of this paragraph.

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43 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of 44 abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee. 45 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with 46 the Secretary of the Senate.

- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary of the Senate a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- (7) **Abolishment**. The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2024.

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
