

## Senate Resolution 623

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the firefighters involved in the heroic rescue at the Avondale  
2 Forest Apartments in Avondale Estates, Georgia, on January 3, 2018; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, firefighters stand ready to protect their communities from fire, accidents, and  
4 other hazards and routinely exhibit courage, selflessness, and heroism in the face of  
5 overwhelming danger; and

6 WHEREAS, on January 3, 2018, a 9-1-1 call was made stating that the Avondale Forest  
7 Apartments were on fire with a second call stating that people were trapped on the third  
8 floor, and the firefighters immediately deployed for duty; and

9 WHEREAS, upon arrival, Assistant Chief Jeff Crump determined that additional resources  
10 would be needed and called for a second alarm response that dispatched an additional ten  
11 units; and

12 WHEREAS, Assistant Chief Jeff Crump, Captain Jackie Peckrul and the crew of Engine 3,  
13 Captain Scott Stroup and the crew of Engine 7, and Captain Jovan Carter and the crew of  
14 Quint 24 worked together and coordinated an incredible rescue; and

15 WHEREAS, the rescue effort assisted a woman confined to a wheelchair, newborn twins, a  
16 toddler, a four-year old girl, a young boy, the children's mother, the children's father, a  
17 son-in-law, and a neighbor a few apartments down from where the fire originated; and

18 WHEREAS, more than 60 firefighters including fire investigation units 502, 503, 505, Air  
19 22, Battalion 3, Battalion 5, Car 2, Car 7, Engine 3, Engine 6, Engine 7, Engine 9, Engine  
20 11, Engine and Truck 20, Engine 22, Engine and Truck 23, Engine 26, Heavy Rescue and  
21 Quint 24, PIO, Truck 1, and Truck 16 responded; and

22 WHEREAS, the outstanding skill, competence, and operational strength of these firefighters  
23 resulted in the rescue of all individuals trapped in the apartments, with no casualties or  
24 life-threatening injuries; and

25 WHEREAS, their remarkable rescue became a state-wide sensation as citizens across the  
26 State of Georgia remarked upon their heroic actions; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of these  
28 extraordinary individuals be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
30 recognize and commend the firefighters involved in the heroic rescue at the Avondale Forest  
31 Apartments in Avondale Estates, Georgia, on January 3, 2018, and express gratitude for their  
32 continued courage, selflessness, and efficacy.
