- 1 Recognizing February 7–14, 2020, as Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week at the state
- 2 capitol; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, congenital heart defects are one of the most frequently occurring birth defects
- 4 and a leading cause of deaths related to birth defects worldwide; and
- 5 WHEREAS, over one million families across America face the challenges and hardships of
- 6 raising children with congenital heart defects; each year, approximately 40,000 babies are
- 7 born in the United States with these conditions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, some congenital heart defects are not diagnosed until months or years after birth
- 9 and when these conditions go undiagnosed, they can cause sudden cardiac death in young
- 10 athletes; and
- WHEREAS, despite these alarming statistics, newborns and young athletes are still not
- 12 regularly screened for congenital heart defects; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week provides an opportunity for families
- 14 whose lives have been affected by congenital heart defects to celebrate life, remember the
- loved ones they have lost, honor dedicated health professionals, and share information with
- the public and the media.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 18 recognize February 7–14, 2020, as Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week at the state
- 19 capitol.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 21 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Children's
- Healthcare of Atlanta and its Kids at Heart program.
