## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 5, 2020, as Advanced Placement Day at the state capitol; and for other

2 purposes.

WHEREAS, the College Board's AP program offers students the opportunity to takechallenging college-level courses while still in high school; and

5 WHEREAS, successful performance, by scoring a 3 or higher, on the AP exams qualifies

6 students to receive college credit at colleges and universities in Georgia and nationwide,

7 representing millions in substantial college tuition savings for students and parents; and

8 WHEREAS, challenging AP curriculum and exams significantly contribute toward building
9 a globally competitive career-ready workforce in Georgia; and

- 10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Education and the College Board, which administer
- 11 the AP program, have a long-standing partnership to build AP in the State of Georgia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 2019, 84,207 Georgia public high school students took 151,728 AP exams
- 13 with 92,645 of those exams having scores of 3 or higher; and

WHEREAS, the above figures represent continued growth in the number of public school
students taking AP exams and scoring 3 or higher on exams in more than 30 subjects,
including computer science.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
recognize February 5, 2020, as Advanced Placement Day at the state capitol.

to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
press.
