A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Jerry C. Colwell and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Jerry C. Colwell was born on September 10, 1949, in Pike County,
4 Georgia, the beloved son of J.C. Colwell, Jr., and Ann S. Colwell; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Colwell owned several businesses throughout his lifetime and got his start
6 with Middle Georgia Water Systems; and

7 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
8 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
9 family and friends were admired by others; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Colwell was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
11 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of
12 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and

13 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable
14 and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his
15 memory.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of U.S. 19 and Old Zebulon Road in Pike
18 County is dedicated as the Jerry C. Colwell Memorial Intersection.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Jerry C. Colwell Memorial
21 Intersection.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
23 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of Mr.
24 Jerry C. Colwell and to the Department of Transportation.
