A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., and recognizing March 12, 2019, as Kappa
2 Alpha Psi Fraternity Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., was founded at Indiana University in
4 Bloomington, Indiana, on January 5, 1911, by ten African American God-fearing, serious
5 minded, courageous young men, and Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., is a proud and active
6 member of the Divine 9 Greek letter organizations; and

7 WHEREAS, under the theme "Training for Leadership," this fraternity promotes intellectual
8 and genuine concern for human development in all directions while holding fast to the
9 principle of achievement; and

10 WHEREAS, the Southeastern Province covering the states of South Carolina, Georgia and
11 South Africa was formed as one of 12 provinces of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., in 1951;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, over 130,000 members of Kappa Alpha Psi are located on college campuses and
14 graduate chapters around the globe; and

15 WHEREAS, the undergraduate and graduate men of the Southeastern Province in the State
16 of Georgia have heeded the call to take a stand on promoting patriotism and civic
17 responsibility to voice concern and request public policies that better serve the African
18 American youth in the United States and abroad, and to speak out on the enforcement of
19 discriminatory laws directly targeted toward African American males, such as stand your
20 ground, stop and frisk, and the continual usage of deadly force; and

21 WHEREAS, Kappa Alpha Psi programs aim to reach the youth on the local level through
22 such initiatives as Kappa League, Guide Right, Kappa Kamp, and the Undergraduate
23 Leadership Institute.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 commend Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., and recognize March 12, 2019, as Kappa Alpha
26 Psi Fraternity Day at the state capitol.
