## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Donsha Johnson and Nicole Folkes-Johnson, owners of Eat

3 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta was founded in 2011 in Ellenwood, Georgia, with the sole  
4 purpose of helping people in Atlanta and the surrounding areas eat better for less; and

5 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta partnered with Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, Piedmont  
6 Healthcare, WellStar Health System, Gwinnett Medical and EMORY Healthcare to provide  
7 fresh fruit and vegetables for hospital employees, patients, and patients' families; and

8 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta started with only seven customers and presently feeds over  
9 400 families a week; and

10 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta is committed to providing fresh fruit and vegetables to the  
11 residents of Atlanta and the surrounding areas and is also committed to fighting the negative  
12 health outcomes that are a result of a poor diet; and

13 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta partners with My Style Matters to provide fresh fruit and  
14 vegetables to women undergoing treatment for cancer; and

15 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta has created jobs in the City of Atlanta; and

16 WHEREAS, Eat Right Atlanta has supported the Georgia agricultural economy by  
17 supporting local Georgia farmers; and

18 WHEREAS, Donsha Johnson and Nicole Folkes-Johnson, through their company Eat Right  
19 Atlanta, continue to take care of the residents of the State of Georgia by providing fresh and  
20 healthy food at an affordable price to all who need it.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
22 recognize and commend Donsha Johnson and Nicole Folkes-Johnson for their many valuable  
23 contributions on behalf of the citizens of Georgia.
