

Senate Resolution 658

ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Supporting the people of Ukraine during the crisis caused by the invasion of Ukraine by the
2 Russian Federation; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on or about February 24, 2022, the Russian Federation began an unprovoked
4 invasion of Ukraine, an independent and sovereign nation; and

5 WHEREAS, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp has proposed and the Georgia General
6 Assembly has agreed to an income tax rebate for all taxpayers in the State of Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, certain members of the Georgia Senate have decided that the best use of their
8 income tax rebate would be to support the Ukrainian people by donating all or a portion of
9 the income tax rebate they receive to a charitable organization that is actively engaged in
10 helping the Ukrainian people during this time of need.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
12 condemn the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation and call on Russia to end its
13 unprovoked aggression.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
15 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Russian

16 Ambassador to the United States, the Ukrainian Ambassador to the United States, and the
17 members of Georgia's congressional delegation.
