## ADOPTED SENATE

## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Supporting the people of Ukraine during the crisis caused by the invasion of Ukraine by the
- 2 Russian Federation; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, on or about February 24, 2022, the Russian Federation began an unprovoked
- 4 invasion of Ukraine, an independent and sovereign nation; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp has proposed and the Georgia General
- 6 Assembly has agreed to an income tax rebate for all taxpayers in the State of Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, certain members of the Georgia Senate have decided that the best use of their
- 8 income tax rebate would be to support the Ukrainian people by donating all or a portion of
- 9 the income tax rebate they receive to a charitable organization that is actively engaged in
- 10 helping the Ukrainian people during this time of need.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 12 condemn the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation and call on Russia to end its
- 13 unprovoked aggression.
- 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 15 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Russian
