

## Senate Resolution 67

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ms. Stephanie Cutter; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Ms. Stephanie Cutter has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for  
3 the vital role that she has played in the leadership of Savannah, Georgia, and her deep  
4 personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, a Savannah native, Ms. Cutter graduated from Windsor Forest High School and  
6 earned both her Bachelor of Accounting and Master of Public Administration degrees from  
7 Savannah State College; and

8 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,  
9 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state, as evidenced  
10 dramatically by her superlative service to the State of Georgia, which began in 1976 with the  
11 Georgia Department of Corrections; and

12 WHEREAS, Ms. Cutter's career with Savannah, Georgia, began in 1989, when she began  
13 working as a budget analyst; over the next decade, she was promoted to senior budget  
14 analyst, management services coordinator for the assistant city manager, and director of the  
15 residential refuse department; in 2002 she was appointed acting chief of the sanitation  
16 bureau; and

17 WHEREAS, she holds national certifications in Solid Waste Collection, Landfill  
18 Management, and Public Works Management, received Senior Executive Leadership  
19 Training from the University of Virginia in 2010, and is a Leadership Savannah graduate;

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Cutter's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable  
22 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the  
23 citizens of this state led to her becoming acting assistant city manager in May, 2010, and

24 assistant city manager of administrative and community services in December, 2011, where  
25 she oversaw two bureaus, Management Services and Community and Economic  
26 Development, which house a total of 28 departments; and

27 WHEREAS, Ms. Cutter's vision and unyielding commitment also led to her appointment as  
28 acting city manager in October, 2012, where she serves with honor and distinction; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
30 remarkable and driven Georgian be appropriately recognized.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
32 recognize and commend Ms. Stephanie Cutter for her efficient, effective, and dedicated  
33 public service to the State of Georgia and extend to her their most sincere best wishes for  
34 continued success.
