## A RESOLUTION

3 capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, 4-H members consistently demonstrate the ability and leadership necessary to  
5 become champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young people  
6 of Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Mason McClintock of Bacon County serves with distinction and dedication  
8 as state 4-H Club president; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Arch D. Smith of the University of Georgia Cooperative Extension has  
10 worked diligently as director and state 4-H leader with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia;

12 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of Jordan Daniels of Tift County,  
13 Andy Martin of Emanuel County, Avery Ray of Gwinnett County, and Bo Wheeler of  
14 Stephens County as district presidents have been acknowledged by the 4-H membership  
15 through their election of these young people to serve in 2017-2018; and

16 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of Ashley  
17 Johnson of Chatham County, Lora Nedza of Oconee County, Kyle Sellers of Columbia  
18 County, and Zach Tellano of Hart County was recognized in Washington, D.C., at the 2017  
19 National 4-H Conference; and

20 WHEREAS, Ben Murray of Berrien County and Sophia Rodriguez of Liberty County were  
21 named 2017 Leadership in Action winners; and

22 WHEREAS, Dalton Green of Walker County, Lauren Pike of Walker County, Kyle Sellers  
23 of Columbia County, Hamp Thomas of Chattooga County, Tyler Tucker of Ben Hill County,  
24 and Kiana Washington of Oconee County were named state winners in the 2017 Dean's  
25 Awards competition; and

26 WHEREAS, Amelia Day of Houston County was selected as winner of the 2017 National  
27 Youth in Action Award for Citizenship and as overall winner of the 2017 National Youth in  
28 Action Award; and

29 WHEREAS, Sara Faulk, Davis Grimsley, Marisa Hutchens, and Hannah Moseley of  
30 Bleckley County were declared the 2017 National Winning Team in the Consumer Decisions  
31 Contest; and

32 WHEREAS, Tyler Tucker of Ben Hill County was named 2017 National Winner in the  
33 Family and Consumer Sciences Demonstration Contest.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
35 recognize February 1, 2018, as 4-H Day at the state capitol and commend the University of  
36 Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences 4-H Program, Mr. Mason

38 delegates, and national award recipients, and commend them for their numerous  
39 accomplishments and committed leadership in 4-H programs throughout the State of
