A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Raymond Goslow; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Georgia was well represented in the *Jeopardy!* National College Championship,
3 which featured 36 undergraduates from across the country competing for a \$250,000 grand
4 prize and the title of *Jeopardy!* National College Champion; and

5 WHEREAS, Kennesaw State University then-senior, Raymond Goslow, made it to the final
6 round of the *Jeopardy!* National College Championship, where he placed second and won
7 a \$100,000 grand prize; and

8 WHEREAS, During his junior year, Goslow, a geospatial sciences major, had a chance to
9 try out for the *Jeopardy!* National College Championship. He began the process in October
10 2020, and a series of tests, interviews, and auditions meant he made it under the wire before
11 his graduation, traveling to California for filming in November 2021; and

12 WHEREAS, Goslow said his geospatial sciences major at KSU, one that involves data
13 analysis from a range of topics using geographic location as a variable, helped expose him
14 to wide range of subjects and further prepare him for *Jeopardy!*; and

15 WHEREAS, the KSU community cheered on alumnus Raymond Goslow on Tuesday night
16 as they watched his performance on the *Jeopardy!* National College Championship final on
17 primetime on ABC. His second-place finish did not dampen the enthusiasm of crowds who
18 gathered to watch on the Kennesaw and Marietta campuses; and

19 WHEREAS, Raymond Goslow has brought great pride to Owl Nation and to the State of
20 Georgia through his impressive run to the finals in *Jeopardy!* National College
21 Championship.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend Raymond Goslow for his success at the *Jeopardy!* National College
24 Championship and his representation of Kennesaw State University.
