## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Celebrating the good life of Jack Prince of Gainesville; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, South Carolina-born Jack Prince passed away in November 2021, and his good  
3 life is remembered as an entrepreneur, inventor, businessman, broadcaster, singer, and family  
4 man; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Prince attained an admirable armed services record with the 11th Airborne  
6 Division occupying Japan at the close of World War II, and he worked for Armed Forces  
7 radio before joining the Army Reserve, which allowed him to attend Brevard College and  
8 the University of North Carolina, where he enlisted in the Air Force ROTC; and
- 9 WHEREAS, majoring in radio broadcasting, he sang with bands and in musical theater,  
10 where he met Patricia Jewell, his future wife, a drama major; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Prince joined his father-in-law's company, the J. D. Jewell Company, in 1951  
12 in sales promotions and eventually became vice president of marketing; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was a community activist who served in the Jaycees, Rotary, and Hall  
14 County library board, as well as the Salvation Army; and

15 WHEREAS, in 1964, he became the first Republican to run for Congress in the 9th District  
16 in 100 years, which launched him in another direction in the poultry industry, having  
17 invented and patented the chicken deboning machine; Jack Prince Inc. manufactured and sold  
18 poultry deboning machines across the world; and

19 WHEREAS, Prince continued to lend his skills and talents to his community as a founding  
20 member of Brenau University's Life and Leisure Institute, where he received its Lifetime  
21 Service Award in 2012, and the Full Gospel Businessman's Fellowship International prison  
22 ministry, as well as a guest speaker and lay leader at interdenominational retreats in the  
23 United States and South America.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
25 join in honoring the life and memory of the visionary marketer and inventor Jack Prince, a  
26 church man, family man, and exceptional and accomplished citizen of Georgia.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
28 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the family of Jack  
29 Prince.
