- 3 WHEREAS, Judge Charles D. "Donny" Peppers, Sr., has long been recognized by the

- 15 partner in the firm of Watson, Dana & Peppers; and
- 16 WHEREAS, in 1985, he was appointed Judge of the State Court of Walker County by then
- 17 Governor Joe Frank Harris, running unopposed for reelection seven times, and serving for
- 18 26 years before retiring on June 30, 2011; and
- 19 WHEREAS, upon his retirement, he was appointed Senior Judge of the State Court by
- 20 Governor Nathan Deal, and his significant leadership talents, his remarkable patience, and
- 21 his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this state have earned him the respect and
- 22 admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

- 27 Council of State Court Judges, served as Chairperson of the Budget and Legislative
- 28 Committees of the Council of State Court Judges, and received the Ogden Doremus Award,
- 29 the most prestigious award offered by the Council of State Court Judges; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Judge Peppers has served with honor and distinction, and his vision and
- 31 unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his retirement, and it is
- 32 therefore abundantly fitting that the outstanding service of this distinguished Georgian be
- 33 appropriately recognized.
