## A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the Capitol Arts Standards Commission to arrange for placement of an agricultural  
2 history museum area in an appropriate location in the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia's farmers have played an essential role in the economic development  
4 of this state, and their history should not be undervalued or forgotten; and

5 WHEREAS, agricultural production in this state generates billions of dollars in revenue,  
6 supports thousands of businesses state wide, provides millions of jobs, and has a multibillion  
7 dollar economic impact on this state; and

8 WHEREAS, collectively this important sector of Georgia's economy not only touches the  
9 lives of every citizen in Georgia but also is an important part of our historical legacy.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
11 urge the Capitol Arts Standards Commission to arrange for placement of an agricultural  
12 history museum area in an appropriate location in the state capitol.
