A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of November as Epilepsy Awareness Month; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, epilepsy is a neurological disorder where the brain's normal electrical pattern
- 3 is disrupted by sudden and synchronized bursts of electrical energy that may affect
- 4 consciousness, movement, or sensation while creating long-term effects on the lifestyle of
- 5 individuals with epilepsy; and
- 6 WHEREAS, one in 26 people will develop epilepsy, and 150,000 new cases of epilepsy are
- 7 diagnosed each year; and
- 8 WHEREAS, epilepsy affects between 2.2 and 3 million people in the United States and more
- 9 than 75,000 people in Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, epilepsy is a complex neurological disorder that results in almost one-third of
- 11 epilepsy patients living with uncontrolled seizures due to a lack of clinically available
- 12 treatment that works for them; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the complexity of this disorder requires further research to find a cure and
- 14 additional treatments for epilepsy patients; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Epilepsy Awareness Month is recognized each November to increase awareness
- of the disorder, highlight the need for further research, and demonstrate support for the
- 17 millions of people living with epilepsy in the United States; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia joins the Epilepsy Foundation and other interested agencies
- and organizations in encouraging patients, supporters, health care providers, and the general
- 20 public to share information about this disease and available treatments, giving hope of a
- 21 better future for people with epilepsy.
