A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Nation of Israel for its cordial and mutually beneficial relationship with the
- 2 United States and the State of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the United States, having been the first country to recognize Israel as an
- 4 independent nation, is Israel's principal ally and has enjoyed a close and mutually beneficial
- 5 relationship with Israel and its people; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Israel is the greatest friend and ally of the United States in the Middle East, and
- 7 the values of the two nations are so intertwined that it is impossible to separate one from the
- 8 other; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia and Israel have enjoyed cordial and mutually beneficial
- 10 relations since 1948, a friendship that continues to strengthen with each passing year; and
- 11 WHEREAS, there is a special bond of friendship between the citizens of Georgia and Israel
- 12 that inspires the people of Georgia to stand with the people of Israel in solidarity and
- 13 welcome all opportunities to grow our already deep relationship at all levels, including
- 14 cultural, academic, and business endeavors; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is proud to serve as home to the Israeli Consulate General
- 16 for the Southeast; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is proud to be the home of more than 45 Israeli companies
- that employ more than 2,000 people; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Economic Development operates an established
- 20 trade office in Israel; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the cities of Atlanta, Georgia, and Ra'anana, Israel, are official sister cities; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the inexorable bonds of camaraderie

- between the Nation of Israel and the State of Georgia be appropriately recognized.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 25 commend Israel for its cordial and mutually beneficial relationship with the United States
- and with the State of Georgia and support Israel in its legal, historical, moral, and God-given
- 27 right of self-governance and self-defense upon the entirety of its own lands, recognizing that
- 28 Israel is neither an attacking force nor an occupier of the lands of others and that peace can
- 29 be afforded the region only through a whole and united Israel.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 31 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Israeli
- 32 Ambassador to the United States, the Honorable Consul General, and the Georgia
- 33 congressional delegation.
