- 15 WHEREAS, Reverend Garner says he had his vision when he was 17 years old, sitting on
- 16 the stage as his father led a church service; and
- 17 WHEREAS, during his vision, Reverend Garner says that Jesus moved very close to him,
- 18 took his head in his hands, and kissed him on the forehead; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he wrote his book because he believes it is his mission to share the word of God
- with others.
