- 23 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Kathy Lewis Carter, and was
- 24 blessed with three remarkable children Holly, Carmen, and Jake; and nine wonderful
- 25 grandchildren, Mallory, Madison, Chad, Bailey, Hailey, Bo, Karson, Kennedy, and Coan;

- WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
- 28 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
