- 23 Barrow County Water Authority, and the Barrow County Farm Bureau, as he is constantly
- 24 seeking ways to encourage and help those around him; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Terry and his wife, Kay, reside in Winder, where in his retirement he continues
- 26 to help others and lead by example; and
