A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the accomplishments of Mrs. Nancy G. McAllister; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Nancy G. McAllister was born in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, to William
3 Kliefoth and the late Vera Kliefoth; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she graduated from Penn Hall College with a degree in Consumer Economics;

- 6 WHEREAS, she has lived in Georgia since 1977 and was employed by Pan American World
7 Airways as a stewardess, account executive, and sales executive; she also worked at IBM as
8 a Major Meetings Planner; and
- 9 WHEREAS, her father, Captain Kliefoth, was a Pan Am pilot, and Nancy has visited over
10 110 countries across the world; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she was a charter member and former president of the Atlanta chapter of World
12 Wings International, Inc., and chaired the convention in Atlanta in 1992 and Savannah in
13 2015; the conventions brought over 1,000 people from all over the world to Georgia and had
14 a combined economic impact of over \$1.3 million; and
- 15 WHEREAS, she has been a member of or participated in many civic and charitable
16 organizations, including the March of Dimes, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, Wesleyan
17 School, Chemoflage, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, and many others; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mrs. McAllister is married to Brooks McAllister and they have one son,
19 Jonathan Gillespie.
