#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 15, 2018, as Alpha Phi Alpha Day at the state capitol; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, since 2008, the Georgia District has sponsored Alpha Phi Alpha Day at the state  
4 capitol, and this year, the dynamic Brothers of the Georgia District will return to the state  
5 capitol to celebrate their eleventh annual event; and

6 WHEREAS, their mission is to launch an initiative, supported by the state legislature, that  
7 will assess and articulate the issues and challenges currently confronting African American  
8 males throughout the State of Georgia; and

9 WHEREAS, their focus will continue to address the district's legislative agenda through a  
10 partnership with Georgia Appleseed, the Southern Center for Human Rights, and Georgia  
11 Legal Services; and

12 WHEREAS, in addition to alumni brothers, college brothers and those being mentored in  
13 chapters across the district are encouraged to participate in the event; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the mission and continued efforts of this  
15 exemplary organization be appropriately recognized.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 recognize February 15, 2018, as Alpha Phi Alpha Day at the state capitol.
