WHEREAS, alongside his wife Kristin, he established Master Peace Church, a virtual

countless individuals in need; and

WHEREAS, as a father of six, a devoted husband, a respected pastor, a compassionate leader, and a 2023 Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award recipient, his impact extends far beyond music, leaving an indelible mark of love and transformation on Atlanta and beyond; and

WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he makes of his life, he makes this world a better place in which to live; and
