## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Chief Warrant Officer Joselyn N. White; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Chief Warrant Officer Joselyn N. White serves as a guardian of this nation's  
4 freedom and liberty with the United States Army, steadfastly serving her fellow Americans  
5 as Chief Warrant Officer II; and

6 WHEREAS, Chief Warrant Officer White is in her fourteenth year of service, currently  
7 serving as Human Resources Officer with the 78th Troop Command in Ellenwood, Georgia;

9 WHEREAS, she has led a prestigious and dedicated career in the military, attending many  
10 schools, programs, and training courses in constant pursuit of improving her skills as a  
11 servant-leader to her country, including warrant officer candidate school, AG Warrant  
12 Officer Basic Course, human resources manager course, organizational self-assessment  
13 course, Army Communities of Excellence examiner course, and AG Warrant Officer  
14 Advance Course; and in her civilian education she has earned a bachelor's degree in history  
15 from Eastern Nazarene College and a master's degree in psychology from the University of

22 National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal with one Campaign Star, Global War  
23 on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal with M Device,  
24 Noncommissioned Officers Professional Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon,  
25 Overseas Service Ribbon, Georgia Meritorious Service Medal with one Boar's Head, Georgia

26 Commendation Medal with one Boar's Head, Georgia Special Operation Ribbon, and  
27 Georgia National Guard Service Medal; and

28 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding dedication, continuing  
29 loyalty, and extraordinary service of this exemplary American be appropriately recognized.
