A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Patricia E. Liddell on her outstanding service to the State of
2 Georgia, both before and since her retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Patricia E. Liddell has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
4 vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Liddell obtained a bachelor of science degree in nursing and a master's
7 degree in hospital administration, and she served in a variety of leadership positions in the
8 Medical Service Corps during her tenure in the United States Army from 1976 to 2004; and

9 WHEREAS, as a Mission Continues Fellow, she helped refurbish Westside Atlanta and
10 assisted in the building of the Columbarium at Riverdale Cemetery on behalf of veterans who
11 do not have a final resting place; and

12 WHEREAS, she recently received the National Recruiter Award and was inducted into the
13 Georgia Military Veterans Hall of Fame on November 4, 2017; and

14 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
15 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
16 dramatically by her superlative service as the Third District Commander of the American
17 Legion Department of Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. Liddell's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
19 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the
20 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
21 associates; and

22 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
23 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

24 WHEREAS, Ms. Liddell's honorable service to her country in the United States Army and
25 her unyielding commitment to United States veterans have set the standard for public service;

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
30 recognize and commend Patricia E. Liddell for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and
31 dedicated public service to the State of Georgia and the United States of America and extend
