A RESOLUTION

Recognizing and celebrating March 2024 as Music in our Schools Month; and for other
 purposes.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Music Educators Association was founded in 1938 and has been
active in music education in Georgia since that time; it currently has approximately 3,000
members who are public school, private school, college and university, and private studio
music teachers; and

WHEREAS, to promote music education in Georgia, it sponsors teacher members
conferences, and, for the student members, it provides performance evaluations for
individuals and ensembles including band, choral, and orchestra at all levels; and

WHEREAS, more than 20,000 students participate in their all-state program; more than
2,000 bands, choruses, and orchestra attend their Large Group Performance Evaluation; and
17,000 students perform for adjudication at their Solo and Ensemble Evaluations; and

WHEREAS, the study of music is basic to the complete education; provides a competitive
edge for successful educational reform; engages students in individual and group activity;
and develops creativity, problem-solving, and critical and evaluative skills; and
