A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending public health nurses; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, public health nurses are an integral part of the health care system in every
- 3 community in Georgia, providing preventive and health promotion services for optimal
- 4 health to citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, public health nurses empower citizens with knowledge and help link the
- 6 residents of all 159 counties to needed health care; and
- 7 WHEREAS, examples of personal preventive services for syphilis and tuberculosis (TB)
- 8 provided in 2015 by public health nurses include: management, including treatment and
- 9 follow-up of contacts, of 1,234 cases of primary and secondary syphilis; medication
- 10 compliance, lab monitoring, education, and contact tracing of 306 cases of TB, 95 percent
- 11 of all the diagnosed TB cases in Georgia; medication compliance resulting in treatment
- 12 completion for 98 percent of 306 TB cases; complete evaluation for active TB disease for
- 13 3,156 contacts to TB cases; TB education and updates to over 500 people, including staff
- 14 from homeless shelters and correctional facilities; and family planning services for 92,798
- 15 females, 96 percent of whom received a contraceptive method; and
- 16 WHEREAS, examples of personal preventive services for HIV provided in 2015 by public
- 17 health nurses include: screening for HIV infection for 128,080 persons and providing highly
- active antiretroviral therapy to 8,557 HIV-infected people to improve health outcomes and
- 19 prevent further disease transmission; and
- 20 WHEREAS, public health nurses also assist in immunizations and the screening, case
- 21 management, and treatment of chronic medical conditions, sexually transmitted infections,
- and cancers; and

23 WHEREAS, public health nurses have a broad knowledge of nursing sciences, public health

- 24 sciences, emergency preparedness, managing mass-vaccination clinics for influenza vaccine,
- and they have effective relationships with community partners; and
- 26 WHEREAS, public health nurses are considered first responders in cases of bio-terrorism or
- 27 natural disaster events and they will be there to answer questions, immunize, and lead and
- 28 guide their communities to safety; and
- 29 WHEREAS, all Georgians owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to public health nurses for the
- 30 outstanding contribution they make to health care in our state.
- 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 32 commend public health nurses and thank them for their invaluable contributions to the health
- and well-being of all Georgians.
- 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 35 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the chief nurse for
- 36 public health at the Department of Public Health, Carole Jakeway and to Cathalene Teahan.
