A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to authorize the General Assembly to
- 2 provide for the proceeds of one or more lottery games to benefit military veterans; to provide
- 3 for authorized purposes; to provide for appropriations; to provide for the submission of this
- 4 amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article I, Section II, Paragraph VIII of the Constitution is amended by adding a new
- 8 subparagraph to read as follows:
- 9 "(e) The General Assembly is authorized to provide for the proceeds of one or more
- games operated within a lottery authorized by subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph to assist
- with one or more of the following purposes as provided by general law:
- 12 (1) Veterans' post traumatic stress disorder;
- 13 (2) Veterans' homelessness;
- 14 (3) The health insurance costs of veterans;
- 15 (4) Veterans' disability benefits, including, but not limited to, disability benefits
- provided by veterans service organizations and veterans assistance commissions or
- 17 <u>centers;</u>

- 18 (5) The long-term care of veterans; and
- 19 (6) Veteran employment and employment training.
- 20 The proceeds of such games shall be accounted for separately and shall be appropriated
- 21 <u>for such purposes in the same manner provided for education purposes in subparagraph (c)</u>
- 22 <u>of this Paragraph.</u>"
- 23 SECTION 2.
- 24 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 25 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

30	All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."	
31	All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If	
32	such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall	
33	become a part of the Constitution of this state.
