A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mayor Willie Ray Oswalt; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Mayor Willie Ray Oswalt on February 10, 2018; and

4 WHEREAS, Mayor Oswalt was born on September 20, 1940, in Columbus, Mississippi, a
5 beloved son of James Festus and Normal Estes Oswalt; and

6 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, LaWanda, and was blessed with
7 two remarkable children, Tamara and Carlton, and eight wonderful grandchildren; and

8 WHEREAS, Mayor Oswalt devoted innumerable hours of his time, talents, and energy
9 toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced by his superlative service on
10 the city council of Lake City, as an educator and football and track coach, with the Atlanta
11 Regional Commission, and as the mayor of Lake City; and

12 WHEREAS, he helped lead efforts to build a new city hall building, to bring a community
13 center to Lake City, and to develop the Willie R. Oswalt Nature Preserve and is one of
14 Georgia's longest-serving mayors; and

15 WHEREAS, Mayor Oswalt gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and
16 deep concern for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he
17 demonstrated to his family and friends were admired by others; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
19 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
20 made this world a better place in which to live; and

21 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mayor Oswalt will long be remembered
22 for his love of family and friendship and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of
23 knowing him.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
25 join in honoring the life and memory of Mayor Willie Ray Oswalt and express their deepest
26 and most sincere regret at his passing.
