

## Senate Resolution 868

## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending and honoring John Bingham McKibbon, Jr., for his induction into the Georgia  
2 Aviation Hall of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a native of Coweta County, and a graduate of Gainesville High School, John  
4 Bingham McKibbon, Jr., attended North Georgia College; and

5 WHEREAS, he earned his pilot's wings in 1942 and in 1944 was piloting B-25 bombers as  
6 part of a five man crew completing 59 missions throughout the Pacific Ocean region,  
7 including New Guinea, the Philippines, the South China Sea, China, and Taiwan during  
8 World War II; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. McKibbon returned to active duty with the United States Air Force during  
10 the Korean War as a pilot of tanker aircraft refueling B-47s and B-50s and a trainer of other  
11 pilots in midair refueling techniques; and

12 WHEREAS, an accomplished pilot, having first flown at age eight with his first solo flight  
13 at age 19, he also taught his wife and children to fly, owned numerous aircraft, and was a  
14 perennial advocate for general aviation; and

15 WHEREAS, this distinguished and decorated serviceman went on to a successful business  
16 career as an industry leader of poultry production, real estate development, and hotel and  
17 hospitality ventures; and

18 WHEREAS, on April 28, 2018, Mr. McKibbon will be formally inducted into the Georgia  
19 Aviation Hall of Fame; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. McKibbon is rightfully deserving of admission into the Georgia Aviation  
21 Hall of Fame for his many successes and the example he has set for so many, and it is both

22 fitting and proper that we recognize this great pilot's contribution to Georgia's aviation  
23 history.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
25 commend and honor John Bingham McKibbon, Jr., for his induction into the Georgia  
26 Aviation Hall of Fame and look forward to seeing this outstanding Georgian's achievements  
27 recognized and recorded in Georgia's aviation history and legacy.
