## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Deb Bailey; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Deb Bailey has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of
the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
7 dramatically by her superlative service with the Northeast Georgia Health System; and

8 WHEREAS, she graduated from the Hall School of Nursing in 1974, earned her bachelor's
9 degree in psychology and nursing from Brenau University, and graduated Summa Cum
10 Laude with her master's degree in nursing from the Medical College of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Deb began her professional career over 43 years ago during a time when
nursing and healthcare, as a whole, shared a very different paradigm than they do today; and

WHEREAS, she began as the head nurse in a psychiatric drug and alcohol unit, and she later
became an associate professor of psychiatric nursing at the Hall School of Nursing; and

WHEREAS, as the healthcare system became more advanced, Deb played a large role in the evolution of women in the healthcare workforce, working as a Computers In Nursing Consultant, which enabled her to travel the world and be one of the first women to ever speak in public in the United Arab Emirates, and serving on the editorial board of the first ever nursing journal devoted to computers in nursing; and

WHEREAS, Deb is very engaged in the current legislative session, while also helping recruit
her successor; and

22 WHEREAS, Deb's career eventually advanced into healthcare administration; she served in

23 the position of Vice President for Nursing at the Northeast Georgia Health System and serves

24 as the Executive Director of Government Affairs; and

WHEREAS, while working for the Northeast Georgia Health System, Deb was appointed
by Governor Perdue to the Committee on Public Health, and later, Governor Deal appointed
her to the Georgia Board of Nursing, the Georgia Hospital Medicaid Financial Program
Advisory Committee, and numerous other state committees; and

WHEREAS, Deb focuses on giving back to her community and currently serves as Mistress of Ceremony for the Masters in the Art of Nursing program and is a member of the Brenau Professional Advisory Board, the University of North Georgia Professional Sciences Advisory Board, the Emory Doctorate Nurse Practitioner Board, the Legislative Taskforce of the Georgia Hospital Association, Georgia Alliance of Community Hospitals, Safety Net Coalition of Hospitals, and the Georgia Chamber; and

WHEREAS, she is also an accomplished writer and author, having published numerousprofessional journals and coauthored several textbooks; and
