## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Frank Thomas on being elected to the National Baseball Hall

2 of Fame; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Frank Thomas is a native of Columbus, Georgia, and because of his remarkable

4 career in professional baseball as one of the game's most prolific hitters, has been elected to

5 the National Baseball Hall of Fame in his first year of eligiblity; and

6 WHEREAS, Frank Thomas is the only player in history to compile a major league record of

7 seven consecutive seasons with a .300 batting average, 20 home runs, at least 100 runs batted

8 in, and 100 walks; and

9 WHEREAS, he is the first Columbus native chosen for any of the professional sports halls10 of fame; and

WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
recognize and commend Frank Thomas on being elected to the National Baseball Hall of
Fame.
