A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Louise Nix on the occasion of her retirement; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Louise Nix was born October 25, 1949, a beloved daughter to Ralph and
4 Bonelle Satterfield and an adored sister to Ronda Rich, the late LaWayne Satterfield, and the
5 late Randall Satterfield; and

6 WHEREAS, Louise graduated from North Hall High School and has lived all her life in
7 White County; and

8 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Rodney Nix, on August 4,
9 1968, and is blessed with two remarkable children, Nicole and Rod, and seven wonderful
10 grandchildren, Jon, Nix, Zoe, Aslyn, Bree, Tripp, and Tyla; and

11 WHEREAS, Louise has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her
12 time, talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
13 dramatically by her superlative service with the United States Postal Service, where she
14 began her career in 1978 and was promoted and assigned to the Postmaster position in

28 Better Home Town Sesquicentennial Committee, has worked with the White County Food
29 Pantry to conduct an annual food drive, has been an active member of the United Postmasters
30 & Managers of America as well as the White County Chamber of Commerce, and is actively
31 involved as a member of Shoal Creek Baptist Church; and

33 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
