A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Isaiah Hugley upon receiving the 2015 Pillars of Professional Management
2 Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Columbus City Manager Isaiah Hugley received the 2015 Pillars of Professional
4 Management Award from the Georgia City/County Management Association (GCCMA);

6 WHEREAS, the GCCMA is a professional association of appointed city and county
7 managers and other government officials representing 535 cities, 159 counties, and other
8 local governments in the State of Georgia; and

10 and advancement of professionalism in Georgia local government through a record of service
11 and other activities; and
