A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life of Private Lonnie S. Rhinehart and dedicating an intersection in his
- 2 memory; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put
- 4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the
- 5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Private Lonnie S. Rhinehart demonstrated a deep personal commitment to
- 7 protecting democracy and a willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety and comfort to
- 8 ensure the well-being of his fellow man; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 10 States Army, valiantly and courageously defending his fellow citizens during World War II
- 11 in Germany; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Private Rhinehart was in battle for 19 days and was 19 years old when he was
- 13 killed on January 20, 1945; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Private Rhinehart embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in
- something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable
- and distinguished American be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his
- 17 memory.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of Battlefield Parkway and Highway 41
- 20 in Catoosa County is dedicated as the Private Lonnie S. Rhinehart Memorial Intersection.
